



## The naturality of wood

Furniture in massive wood has a real soul and it is searched both by its strength and its plastic qualities. The wood has an indescribable touch and look, which allows it to create a real "ambiance" around it, which will give great richness to a houses' interior.

The wood, even after being cut, continues to evolve being, therefore, considered a live material. The wood has character, has knots, small cracks as well as slightly colour differences making of each piece a unique one.

Over time there may appear some small cracks in the wood; it is a natural process which occurs due to temperature and moisture changes. Even considering that the wood we use is a well dried and stabilized wood, it can suffer some changes if it is not preserved in the right conditions. Inside of a house wood acts as a regulator, the small changes in moisture or temperature are absorbed by it without causing it any harm but, with bigger changes, the wood can react.

In order to avoid these problems, we advise to protect the furniture from direct sun light as well as from big heat sources, just like radiators or fireplaces.

## Specificities which adds value

A piece of furniture can have slight colour differences, which are completely normal because each tree is unique and non-uniform. Besides that, it can also contain some knots, which certifies that we're in the presence of a natural material, with its own specificities that composes all its character.

Even if the strong points of the massive wood furniture are, without any doubt, its durability, toughness and raw-material beauty, it is essential a good maintenance to well preserve it.

It is necessary to always use a dry or damp cloth, or a sponge with no abrasives, to clean the furniture. Our furniture has a waterproof treatment, nevertheless it is necessary to clean, immediately, with a dry cloth, any liquid that might accidentally spill on it.

A good maintenance is a guarantee for the good preservation of the furniture which can, that way, build a history within the home and the family it belongs to.
